In the year 2004 after the opening of the new YWAM Nehemiah House in Cagayan de Oro City, God began to birth in the hearts of the leaders to have another center located in Bukidnon. This new center would not only be a 24 hour residential facility for abused girls, but would also act as a training facility and provide lively-hood for the out of school clients. At the same time, the idea of purchasing the Tuburan sa pag uswag (Source of Progress) farm was born. The farm will help generate income for the operation of the two centers and provide a training environment for the clients to learn agriculture.

On 22nd of March 2006 those two ideas were merged with the purchase of a 3.5 hector lot located in Patpat, Malaybalay City. Then on June 7th 2006, we began the construction of the new center. This new center can house 18-20 clients and 8-10 staff.

The new center will have several sewing machines, a beauty parlor, a bake shop and an agriculture facility for training in agriculture.

The theme for our opening is: "Blessed to be a Blessing".

Gen 12: 2 I will give you many descendants, and they will become a great nation. I will bless you and make your name famous, so that you will be a blessing.
