Greetings from the warm country Philippines! We are already more than 1 month here since we arrived, time goes so fast without realizing that soon it will be Christmas or soon it will be the end of this year. Wow!!!

Thank God in how He orders our lives here and we are so blessed for what He has done to each and every one of us. Though sometimes there was a time that our son and I, did not feel well and God was so faithful in healing us.

November 13, we moved to the new Nehemiah House in Malaybaly. We are working as a team together with an single staff and we are teaching and training the girls in different kind of skills. For example first plan is teaching girls for farming then we also want to get an oven for teaching the girls in baking bread and also sewing machines. This will be the first project like this in the Philippines teaching out of school girls in becoming independent so later they can use their skills to work for their livelihood.

Aside from working together, Andy is in charge of the farm, he and Michael will work together. I (Ana) will do the kitchen and other duties and our single staff Marel will be in charge of the finances.

About Andrew, we send him to a christian school in malaybalay it is about 7 kms from Pat pat were our Nehemiah farm is, so we will drive him everyday.

My family here in Cagayan de Oro, we are so happy to share with you that we already started to have a prayer meeting once a week. It's interesting to reach my family. They are so open now to hear about the gospel also seeing what we are doing.

The place in Patpat, Malaybalay is not as hot compared to the city in Cagayan and it is windy that's why one of our projects is also to build an windmill for generating power. We don't have any telephone connection there so we only can be reached per handy. The good thing is we have electricity and good water connection which is very important for living.

God provided a place for us to stay, as big as our living room in Germany. He blessed the ministry with a car to use as transportation for we are really in the midst of pineapple fields and there is no transportation available. Just lately a friend blessed Michael with an water purifier and including a electric stove for using in Malaybalay.

We really thank God for His continued blessings.

Soon it will be Christmas and now and then we can hear Christmas songs, fire crackers, everywhere Christmas decoration. But we are excited and looking forward to that time too.
